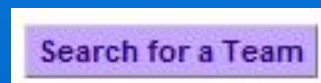
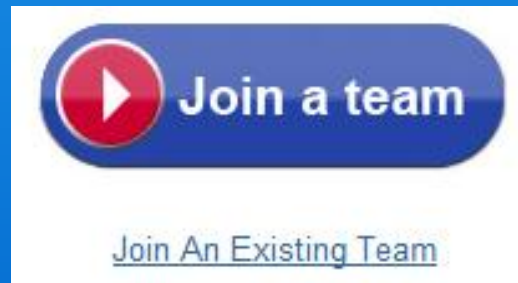

*You cannot take these in consecutive semesters

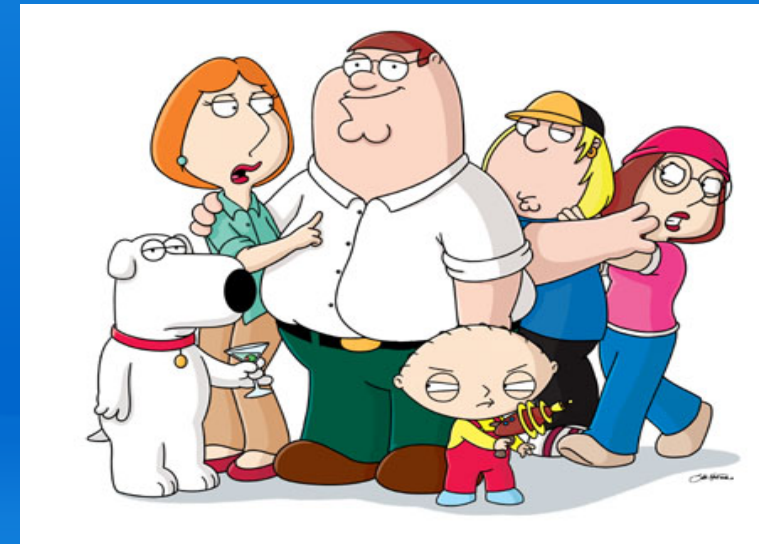

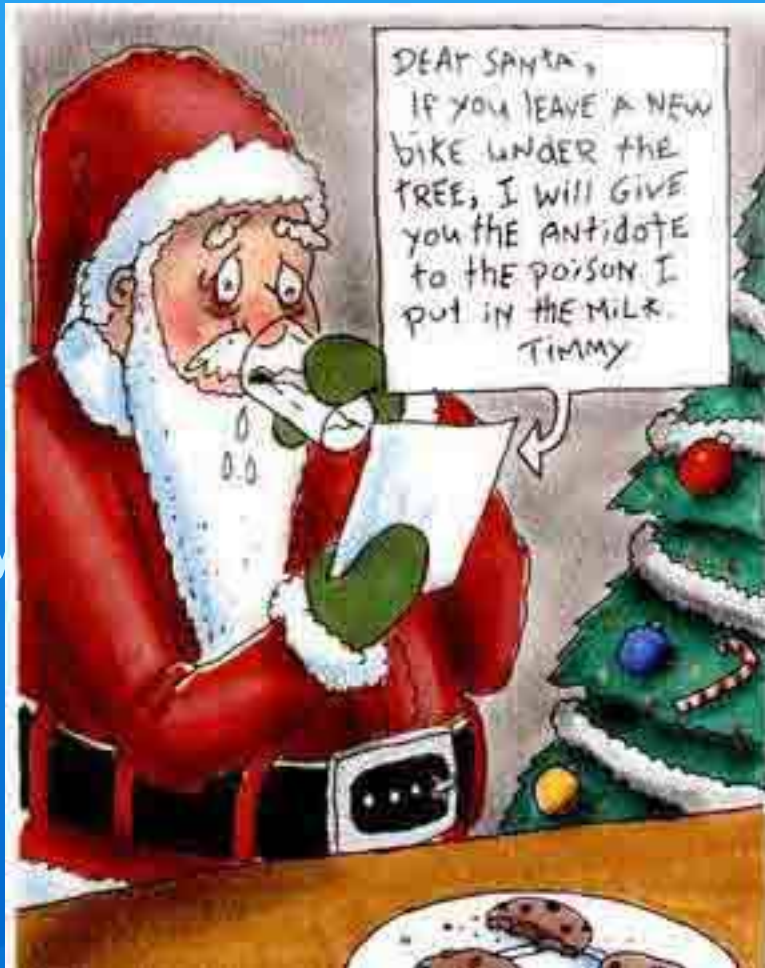
Each Family will be ranked from 1st to 12th in the following categories:

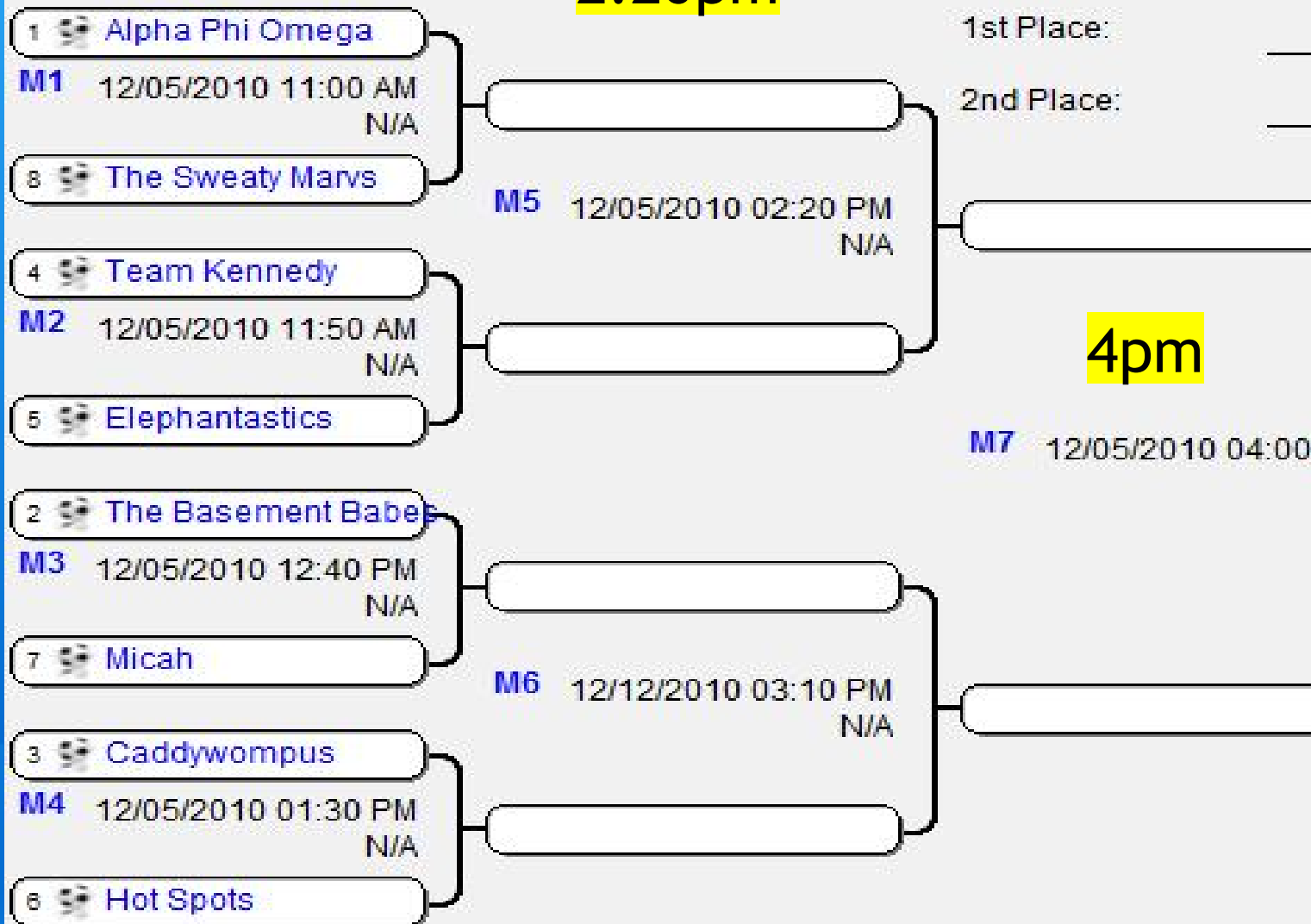

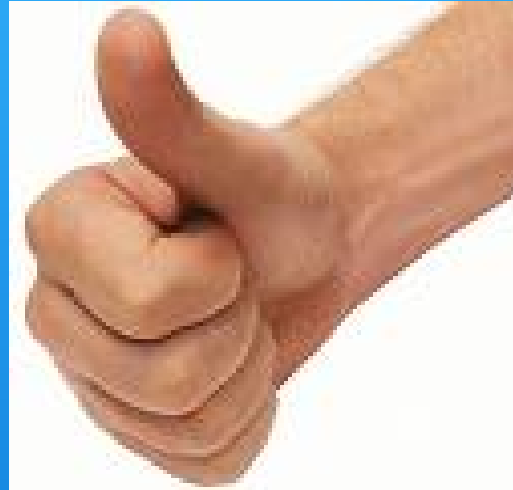
