E-board's Vision

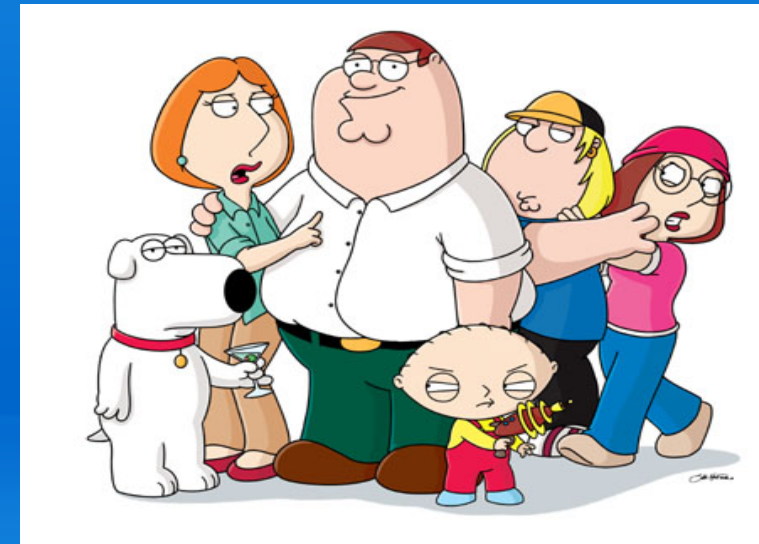
