Humans vs. Zombies



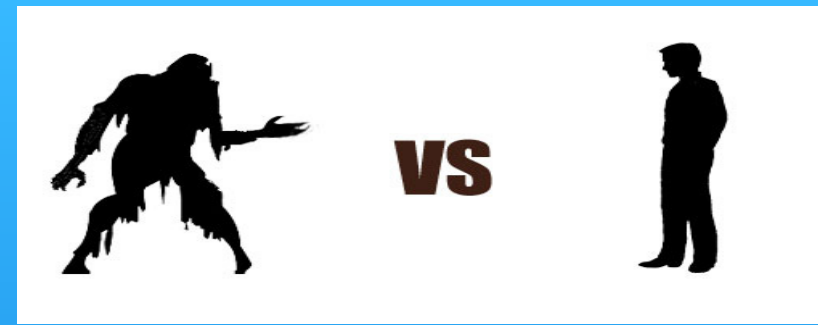

Humans vs. Zombies



- starts with one zombie (bandana on head), others are humans (bandana on arm/leg)
- "feed" every 48 hours by tagging a human, otherwise out
- each human has an ID number which is given to the zombie in order to report their "feed"
- humans can stun zombies by throwing socks
 - stun = cannot interact with the game for 15 minutes
- zombies win if all humans are changed into zombies, humans win if zombies starve

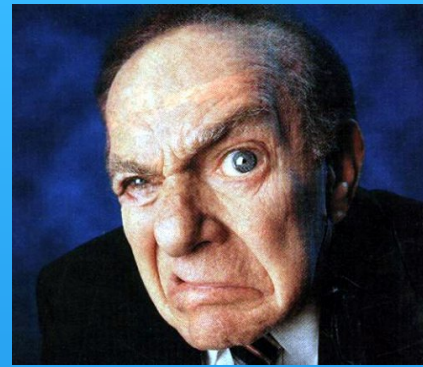
Log service hours as you do them. Do not wait until the end of the semester-- it is hard to remember the service you have done months later.

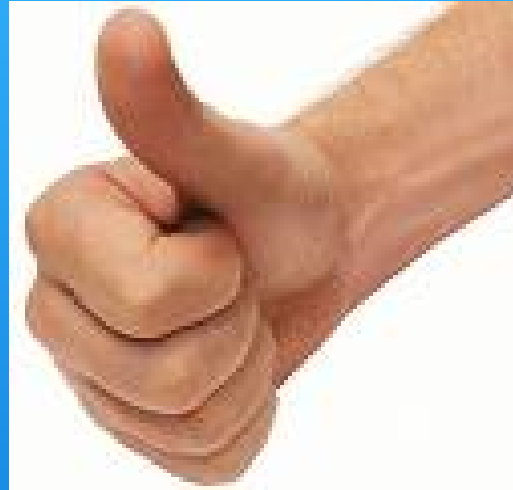

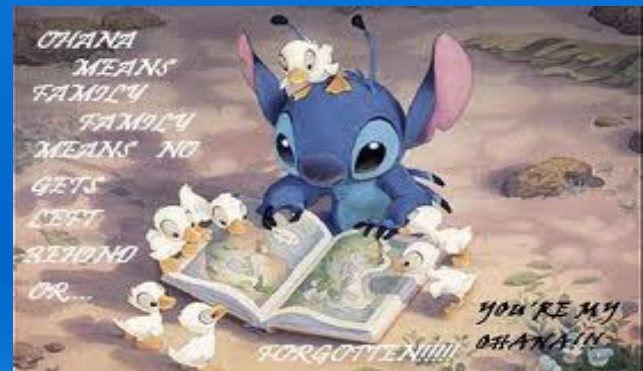
